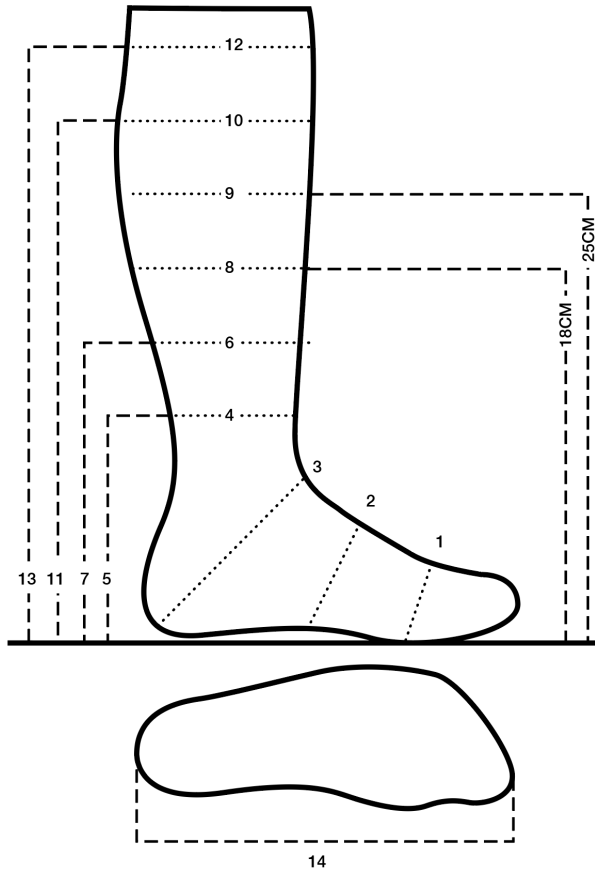

Instructions

All measurements should be taken while person is seated with legs 90 degrees from the floor. Trace both feet on following pages while person is standing. Make sure pencil is held perpendicular to the floor while tracing.

1- With your normal boot socks on. Stand on a piece of paper with your feet relaxed and parallel, toes facing forward.

2 - Using a tape measure, take measurements from the heel, instep and ball of the feet (See diagram below for correct position).

3 - Next measure up the leg at the intervals indicated in the diagram below. This will correspond to how tall you would like your boots.

Measurements in MM (Left foot / right foot)

1 - Around joint (ball) girth (widest)	/
2 - Around instep	/
3 - Around long heel	/
4 - Around ankle	/
5 - Ankle bone height	/
6 - Around above ankle	/
7 - Above ankle height	/

8 - Around 18cm	/
9 - Around 25cm	/
10 - Around calf	/
11 - Calf height	/
12 - Around below knee	/
13 - Height below knee	/
14 - Length of foot	/
